# Andrew G. Haley

## Attorney/Industrialist

- Counsel to the Federal Communications Commission
- Drafted into USAAF JAG Corps 1942
- Gen. Hap Arnold directed him to assist Theodore von Kármán at CalTech
- Co-founder, President & Managing Director of Aerojet Engineering Corporation 1942-1946
- Returned to law practice in Wash. DC 1946
- Consultant to US Senate 1946

# Andrew G. Haley

## Served the International Astronautical Federation

- Elected IAF VP at London in 1951(served 3 yrs)
- Served as Co-Chair of IAF International Relations from 1953-1956
- Elected IAF Representative to UNESCO in 1956
- Elected President of the IAF in 1957 and re-elected President in 1958
- Proposed creation of IAA and later IISL in 1958 and 1959.
- Created IISL's A. G. Haley Gold Medal Award

## Author/Journalist:

- Annual summaries of IAF activities in ***Jet Propulsion*** thru the 1950s
- ***Rocketry and Space Exploration: the International Story*** (Van Nostrand 1958)
- ***Space Law and Government*** ( Appleton, Century Croft 1963)
- More than 250 articles, papers and lectures on space law from 1955 to 1966

# Andrew G. Haley

## Pioneer Space Lawyer/Lecturer

- Lead US effort during the mid 1950s to obtain ITU allocations of frequencies for satellite communication services.
- 1957 Lecture Tours with Welf Heinrich, Prince of Hanover; US - 30; Europe - 13 major universities
- Participated actively in creation of the:
  - IAF and its International Relations Committee
  - IAA and the IISL
  - AIAA and its Committee on Law & Sociology
  - ABA Committee on Space Law, first Vice Chairman
