Olga S. Stelmakh is a Chief Specialist at the International Relations Department, National Space Agency of Ukraine. Prior to this, she was a legal analyst / research fellow with the International Center for Space Law in Ukraine. She had interned at the European Space Agency, the Supreme Economic Court of Ukraine and at a leading Ukrainian law firm. She has an LL.M. from the Kiev National University of Trade and Economics and from the Institute of Space and Telecommunications Law, University of Paris XI and is currently a PhD Candidate both at IDEST (Paris, France) and at the Institute for State and Law, National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine. She has also completed an advanced Space Law and Policy program at the European Center for Space Law and the Space Studies Program at the International Space University.
